

Adventure into Nature

Toodyay is home to four true seasons. The landscapes change dramatically throughout the year and each change is beautiful.

Whether you visit for the green rolling hills, the cool foggy mornings or the quintessential golden summers, you will see a striking countryside.

Explore the magnificent scenery within the many nature reserves in and around Toodyay. Take an energetic hike or a relaxing stroll along the firebreaks to appreciate pristine bushland.

There are many native species of flora and fauna to be found, including Wandoo and the black cockatoo. The Avon Valley National Park features forests and granite outcrops with panoramic views over the Avon Valley, with the stunning Avon River running through



Wildflowers

Wildflowers are abundant during the wildflower season (August to October). Roadsides are lined with lechenaultias and wattle, and nature reserves are home to many species of orchid.

Every year there is an impressive display of pink everlastings at Pelham Reserve.

Go to toodyay.com or the Toodyay Visitor Centre (during wildflower season) to find confirmed wildflower locations.



Noongar Night Skies

Australian Aboriginals are often credited with being the world's first astronomers. Aboriginal astronomy is an important part of Noongar history.

Worl Wangkiny (sky stories) - observing and interpreting the night sky has been used for navigation, calendars, ceremony, cultural lore, song-lines and art for thousands of years.

To experience the wonders of the night sky the Toodyay (Dudja) region is perfect and known for its clear dark nights.



Walk Trails

Foodyay has a number of walk trails, both in natural and urban settings. Brochures can be found at the Foodyay Visitor Centre.





Bilya Walk Track | Duidgee Park, Toodyay

An easy trail by the river between the Toodyay Caravan Park and Nardie Cemetery. The whole journey is 6.5kms one way, but there are a number of access points to shorten the walk.



Pelham Reserve | Duke Street, Toodyay

Starting from the Pelham Reserve Lookout there are a number of walks totalling 6km. Explore natural bush all year round or visit in spring to see the colourful display of everlastings.



Living History Walk Trails | Stirling Terrace, Toodyay

Discover Toodyay's rich history on a journey through Toodyay's historic Main Street. There are four trail options, each exploring a different area of the town.



Dawn Atwell Reserve | Julimar Road

Easily accessed from Julimar Road, Dawn Atwell Reserve has a 5km perimeter track and two shorter tracks. During spring the area is home to many wildflower species including the endangered Star Orchid.



Wongamine Reserve | Forest Road

A nature reserve with a network of over 6.5km of medium difficulty walking tracks through diverse vegetation. Some areas have gravelly slopes and steep gullies. Parking is located on Forest Road and Bejoording Road.



Majestic Heights | Sandplain Road

A slightly challenging 2km (one way) walk through woodlands to a spectacular view point. At the top there are views of Knockdomine Hill and Millard's Pool. In spring the everlastings are a wonderful sight.

Adventure into History



Toodyay is one of the oldest inland towns in Western Australia and much of its heritage is preserved. Noongar people were the first inhabitants, followed by European explorers and then settlers from the 1830s onwards.

The original town of Toodyay was established in 1836, five kilometres down river from where it is today. In 1860 the town of Newcastle was established around the Convict Hiring Depot which coordinated the local convicts and ticket of leave holders. Most settlers moved to Toodyay to take up land grants for farming.

By the beginning of the twentieth century Newcastle had grown, while Toodyay had declined. In 1910 the town of Newcastle changed its name to Toodyay and the old Toodyay town site became West Toodyay.

The Toodyay community supported the World Wars, with many young men enrolled from the district. Today the Toodyay War Memorial proudly recognises their sacrifices.

Since the mid twentieth century, Toodyay has developed at a sedate pace and thereby retaining much of its built heritage. Discover Toodyay's history by following the Toodyaypedia QR codes on the main street, or by visiting the two museums.

Where the Legend of Moondyne Joe began...

Moondyne Joe is infamous for his break outs from the Fremantle Gaol - but his escapee life actually started in Toodyay.

Caught for illegally branding a horse, Joseph Bolitho Johns promptly escaped from the Toodyay lockup - taking the same horse he had branded plus the magistrate's saddle and bridle.

His escape infuriated the Magistrate who demanded a new, stronger gaol (prompting the construction of the Newcastle Gaol).

Once recaptured, Joe was sent to Fremantle where his story continued.

The tale of Moondyne Joe is brought to life at the Newcastle Gaol Museum.








